Mississinewa Tennis History

The Ole Miss Tennis Program is one of the prides of Mississinewa. It is well known across the entire state, having played over 100 different schools from all corners of the state and while having played most of the top-ranked schools in the state. Ole Miss Tennis has had many individual and team successes, which are great accomplishments since tennis is not a class sport in Indiana high school sports. The Mississinewa Tennis Program has advanced individuals to the state finals and the 2021 boy's team advanced to the semi-state level of the state tournament. The boys and girls teams have earned many conference championships as well as winning several sectional titles and have often had the #1 player in the conference. Mississinewa Tennis Players have been named to All-District Teams, All-State Teams, All-Star Teams, and Academic All-State Teams. Many players have continued their competition at the collegiate level. Currently, the girl's team has a streak of 16 consecutive seasons with a winning record while the boy's team has 20 winning seasons in the past 23 seasons. Mississinewa started its tennis program in the 1970-1971 school year. Ole Miss joined the Central Indiana Conference for athletics in 1977.
